Abstract: *The present paper reveals some aspects of the most discussed and frightening, but provocative, superstitions that have deep roots in the archaic belief of the Romanian rural environment. The undefined silhouettes and the cold looks of the most feared entities in our mythology, the moroes and strigoes, who are part of the traditional mystical-religious universe of the traditional village, will be identified, defined and debated as seen, received and given from generation to generation, in the spirit of the community in Cajvana. The purpose of the research is to present the fantastic and cold world of moths, moronics, strikes and shouts flying on the moon on full moon nights, insisting on the differences between the types of unclean and restless spirits, but also how they can be identified and "defeat". For a better understanding of these, I will also bring to the attention stories resulting from my field investigations.*
